How to apply

Application Procedure for Candidates

⚠ Important: Before submitting your application, please make sure you have obtained formal approval from your hierarchy and your Human Resources Department to attend this course.

2. Then, in the top-right corner of the Microsoft Forms, **click the three-dot menu (...)**
3. Select **"Print response"**.
4. In the Print dialog box, choose **"Save as PDF"** as the destination.
5. **Save the PDF file.**
6. **Ensure this PDF file is sent before the deadline fixed on January 9th, 2026** to the ATTF partner in your country, following your usual internal procedures for ATTF training applications.

Please be aware that the ATTF will verify with its country partners whether your application has been received (pdf of the Microsoft Forms) and has been validated by them.

If you are selected, the House of Training-ATTF will inform its partner in your country during the week of January 12th, 2026. You will then receive the confirmation documents & the invoice.

Mrs Bérengère Delahaut, from ACAMS, will contact you directly in the days following your selection with instruction on how to complete your registration with them. Once your application is approved and your invoice is paid you will then be informed on how to book your online exam.

For your registration to be final you will have to proceed with the following:

Before 20 th January , 2026	Validate your application on ACAMS website and provide the required certificates and diplomas on their website.
Between 26 th & 30 th January, 2026	Proceed with your registration to the exam and choose the exam date on ACAMS website. Last day to sit the exam is March 31st, 2026 for edition 1 and November 30th, 2026 for Edition 2

The House of Training will liaise with ACAMS® to ensure that the selected participants are granted a membership, which will be included in the contribution fee that they will be requested to pay for this seminar. Please refer to the attached Financial Conditions for more details.



The Study Guide for preparing the exam will be sent to selected participants after the payment is made, that is why we encourage to you to proceed as soon as you receive your selection confirmation.
