**Financial conditions**

The cost of the course will be covered by the Luxembourg Government without any contribution from the participants.

However, all costs related to the trip to and stay in Luxembourg are to be paid by the participants, who are responsible for booking their flights and accommodation.

Selected professionals will join Luxembourg-based professionals working in the field to follow this 5-day intensive CFSSO programme.

**Who can apply?**

Professionals who:

- ✓ are citizens and/or residents of one of the [ATTF partner countries](#);
- ✓ fit the target audience;
- ✓ are motivated to deepen their knowledge in the field and committed to take the online exam within 7 days from the end of the course.

**Target audience**

Professionals who are interested in or currently working in the financial sector and seeking a certification as a Financial Sector Security Officer. This may include employees from financial institutions such as banks, payment institutions, investment firms, microfinance institutions and other organisations operating in the financial industry.

A background and experience in ICT and/or information security is required.

The seminar and the exam will be conducted in English without any translation. Therefore, a very





good knowledge of English is essential to ensure all participants maximise their benefit from the course and enhance the chances to pass the exam.

### **Examination**

The knowledge acquired in the seminar will be validated through a 2-hour online examination. The examination is based on a MCQ questionnaire of around 30 questions. The required passing rate is 60%.

The link to the examination will be sent at the end of the course. Candidates will have 7 days to take it, after which the exam will no longer be available. It is therefore mandatory to respect the deadline.

Participants who will successfully complete the examination will receive the certificate of completion "**CERTIFIED FINANCIAL SECTOR SECURITY OFFICER (CFSSO)**" co-signed by the Luxembourg Bankers' Association (ABBL).

Only complete applications will be retained. Candidates with the most relevant profiles in reference to the target group and with pertinent motivations are most likely to be selected.
