With reference to the stated project, Clarification No. 5, and the Request for Proposals procedure for the procurement of Design, Development and Implementation of the Integrated Agricultural Information Platform (IAIP), including the State-owned Land Management Information System (SALMIS), RFP No. AMP-GO-RFP-SC2.1-3, and pursuant to Instructions to Proposers (ITP), Clauses 8.1 and 8.2, please be informed that the relevant provisions of the Request for Proposals Document are amended as follows:

All other submission and opening arrangements, including the submission address, opening location and two-envelope procedure, remain unchanged.

ITP 20.4: Any Proposal not accompanied by a substantially responsive Proposal Security shall be rejected by the Purchaser as non-responsive. PDS ITP 20.1: A Proposal Security shall be required. 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		The determination of responsiveness shall be based on whether the Proposal Security existed, was validly issued, authentic, effective and legally enforceable as of 17 August 2026 at 12:00 hours local time. Any verification undertaken by the Purchaser after that deadline shall serve solely to confirm the status of the Proposal Security as of the deadline and shall not permit the Proposal Security to be issued, amended, completed, replaced or otherwise perfected after the deadline. All other requirements under ITP 20, including the amount, required content, the validity period specified in this Amendment No. 4 and the requirements applicable to a Proposal Security submitted by a Joint Venture, remain unchanged.
Section II - Proposal Data Sheet (PDS), ITP 22.1 and ITP 23.1	Current provisions: PDS ITP 22.1: In addition to the original of the Proposal, the Proposer shall submit one (1) USB flash drive containing a complete scanned copy of the Technical Part of the Proposal in PDF format. In case of any discrepancy, the hard copy original shall prevail. PDS ITP 23.1: Proposers shall not have the option of submitting their Proposals electronically.	The existing provisions are supplemented with the following: Where the Proposal Security is furnished as an original electronically issued and authenticated bank guarantee in accordance with PDS ITP 20.1, a legible printed representation of the electronic guarantee shall be included in the hard-copy Technical Part of the Proposal. For submission purposes, the printed representation shall evidence the electronic original, provided that the requirements of PDS ITP 20.1 are met. The printed representation shall contain or clearly reference the information necessary for independent verification of the electronic authentication. For the Proposal Security only, in the event of any discrepancy between the printed representation and the securely authenticated electronic record verifiable under PDS ITP 20.1, the securely authenticated electronic record shall prevail. For all other documents comprising the Proposal, the existing precedence of the hard-copy original remains unchanged. The acceptance of an original electronically issued and authenticated bank guarantee as Proposal Security shall not be interpreted as permitting electronic submission of the Proposal. The complete hard-copy Technical Part and Financial Part, including the printed representation of any electronically issued Proposal Security, shall be physically received by the Purchaser no later than 17 August 2026 at 12:00 hours local time, in accordance with the two-envelope procedure.

Legal effect and precedence. This Amendment No. 4 forms an integral part of the RFP Document. In the event of any inconsistency between this Amendment No. 4 and the RFP Document, Amendment No. 1, Amendment No. 2 or Amendment No. 3, this Amendment No. 4 shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency. Amendment No. 1, Amendment No. 2 and Amendment No. 3 shall remain in full force and effect except to the extent expressly modified by this Amendment No. 4.

All other terms and conditions of the Request for Proposals Document remain unchanged.
