Q1.	Can a residential building—constructed and already put into service by the Bidder as a proprietary investment, and featuring installed video surveillance and an entry/exit control system—be considered a relevant reference?	A1.	Please be informed that ITT, point 12.2 has provided that: "The Tenderer must have successfully completed at least 1 work contract as a prime contractor for construction/ reconstruction of high-level security buildings /or public building with organized security zones and technical security (eg. entry/exit access control, CCTV, safety door etc), in an amount of at least 1.000,000.00 EUR within the last 5 years up to the submission deadline of this tender. The contract is considered completed if certificate of completion, taking over or equivalent certificate is issued by the Employers / Contracting Authorities/ Engineer/ Beneficiary clearly indicating the date of issuing of the aforementioned certificates.



		Completion means that the project the tenderer refers to could have been started/implemented/completed at any time during the indicated period but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period. In case of a joint venture/consortium, the Leader of the joint venture/consortium must satisfy the requirement regarding the experience as contractor listed under point c) above. For the purpose of this tender, Prime Contractor shall be considered a legal entity that was member of joint venture/consortium with the highest financial percentage in a reference project." The Contracting Authority cannot give its opinion on the compliance of the tenderer. It is responsibility of the Evaluation committee at the time of evaluation of tenders.
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
