Actual results	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Renovation Plan for Central Government Buildings was formally adopted by the Government at its 119th Session held on 14 October 2025. - The Government mandated the Ministry of Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources to establish a Project Implementation Unit (PIU) to support the administration and implementation of the Renovation Plan. - The Government of the Republic of North Macedonia, at the 129th Session held on 18 November 2025, on the occasion of the indication of MA Orhan Murtezani, Minister of European Affairs, and regarding Conclusion No. 2 of Item 81 "Information on adopting a Renovation Plan for Central Government Buildings", from the Draft Minutes of the 119th Session of the Government of the Republic of North Macedonia, held on 14 October 2025, concluded that it should be amended to read "The Ministry of Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources is hereby instructed to establish a Project Implementation Unit (PIU) within the Ministry of Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources, to assist in the administration of The Renovation Plan for Central Government Buildings". - The Government, at its 137th Session held on 16 December 2025, has mandated the following institutions, within 7 (seven) days, to submit nominations for a member of the Supervisory Board, which will manage the implementation of The Renovation Plan for Central Government Buildings: Ministry of Health, Ministry of Health - State Sanitary and Health Inspectorate, State Statistical Office, Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management - Directorate for Hydrometeorological Affairs, Ministry of Economy and Labor, Ministry of Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources - State Inspectorate for Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources, Ministry of Public Administration, Ministry of Education and Science, Ministry of Local Self-Government, Ministry of Digital Transformation - Directorate for
